



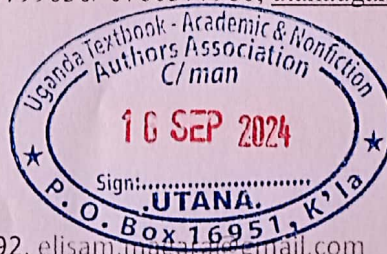
## YOUNG WRITERS' COMPETITION
